The McCormick Freedom Project is seeking entries for its annual contest, **Seen & Heard: National Student Expression Contest and Exhibit**. The contest encourages teens to depict their thoughts on contemporary freedom issues through film, editorial cartoons, Web design and photojournalism.

Prizes:

Nearly \$5000 in cash prizes.

Top entries exhibited in Chicago from April 17-May 28, 2010.

Roundtrip tickets and accommodations to Chicago for the top two students in each category, along with their teacher and a parent, for the opening reception of the Seen & Heard exhibit and student workshop on May 1, 2010.

Eligibility:

High school students, grades 9 – 12, at time of entry. Students may attend a high school or be home-schooled and must reside in the United States. First-place winners from Hawaii and Alaska will receive the cash prize, but will not be flown to Chicago. All entries should focus on contemporary, social, political and economic issues.

Important Dates:

Contest entries must be postmarked by **February 5, 2010**.

Winners announced on **March 5, 2010**.
